



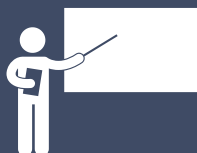

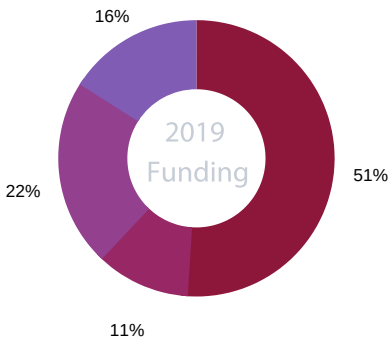
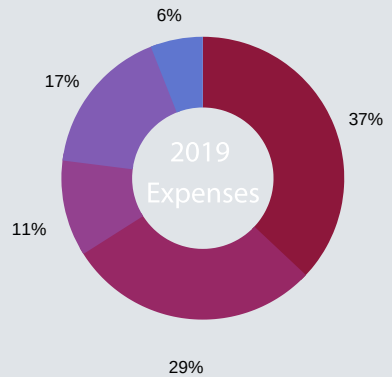
FY2019 Highlights



- Received funding from Jane’s Trust to deepen and expand our prevention and community engagement work. With their support, we hired a Volunteer Program Coordinator and developed a focused strategy for deepening community skill building in five communities.
- Advocated at the State House for systemic changes that often present barriers for survivors:
 - #SafeCommunitiesAct with Latina survivors sharing their stories on the lack of protections in our communities make every day dangerous;
 - #LifttheCaponKids advocating for the well-being and care for children in Massachusetts;
 - Showing up to ask for more reasonable funding for the few remaining safety nets for individuals and families in crisis.
- Crafted a compensation philosophy based on our value of caring for one another with more flexible paid time off, flexible sick and bereavement leave as well as a new four-week sabbatical after seven years of working at REACH.
