We are currently in need of the following items:

For the Home:

- Bedding (sheet sets, blankets, comforters) – highest need is twin-size and queen-size
- Bath towels and washcloths
- Pots and pans (sets)
- Dishware and silverware (sets)
- Shower curtains/shower curtain rings
- Paper goods (tissues, paper towels, paper napkins, toilet paper)
- Feminine products
- **Full sized and travel sized shampoo and conditioner**
- **Dental hygiene products (toothbrushes, toothpaste, floss)**
- Socks and underwear
- **Laundry detergent**
- **Deodorant**
- Swiffer wet and Swiffer dry cloths
